Summer Session Classes will require us to have a roster due to the pandemic. For this reason, we will NOT be offering our typical Pass to Explore, but instead, ask students to register for the style of classes they will participate in.

To be thoughtful of potential dates your student may be traveling, we are only charging for FIVE of the SEVEN classes. You are welcome, and encouraged to attend all seven, however, we are charging for five, so you are not paying for potential missed classes.

Please enclose **\$80 per class style** you are registering for. For a deeper discount, If an individual dancer registers for 6 class styles (\$480), they may register for additional styles at no cost. (NOTE: This does not include camps, and workshops)

Early registration is encouraged, as we will limit the numbers we will allow in each class.

Monday -Thursday June 14-17 10:30am-2:30pm Dancers will be divided based on age and experience. They will work to build on their Jazz skills, with drills for flexibility, strength, leaps, turns, and tricks. They will explore across the floor and center combinations for Classical and Commercial Jazz, and dive into the styles of Broadway Jazz and Instructors: Brooke Kiehl & Katie Taintor Contemporary.

Competition Team Audition Camp Mon.-Thurs. June 28-July 1 \$220 Dancers entering third -twelfth grade, who are interested in dancing 4 hours a week next season, (Ballet, Lyrical, Jazz, Conditioning), participating in three dance competitions, a dance convention, and having the opportunity to choose if they would like to participate in a trip, should plan to attend this 4 day dance camp. At Camp, you will work to develop dance skills, and receive exercises to enhance your strength, flexibility, stamina, and storytelling. The audition will take place as part of the camp, with team building activities rounding out the final afternoon. Students should bring a water bottle each day.

We will be auditioning only competition team dancers during this week. Ballet Company Students not on Team, do not need to attend this week, but should instead, attend the Ballet Intensive Week.

Need information to help you decide if you would like to be on team?

In 2020-21 RVDA has 6 ballet, lyrical/jazz teams, a tap team, and a hip hop team. The current age ranges of the teams are: (3rd-5th), (5th-7th), (7th-8th), and 3 (9th-12th teams advanced beginner, intermediate, and advanced). There is one Tap team (5th -7th), and one Hip Hop team (7th -12th). The configuration of teams for 2021-2022 will be based on who auditions, and the skills those dancers have obtained, and are working on. Dancers should audition for team if they are willing to be committed to the program, and the dancers on their team. They can look forward to group social activities, Friendsgiving, many performances, community service opportunities, competition, and a team trip! Before auditioning for Team, dancers should have some foundational skills under their belt. The youngest team will need to execute, a single pirouette, a piqué and chainé turn, a leap, and link together glissade, jeté, pas de bourré. As the teams advance, so do the skills.

Over the years, Teams have had the opportunity to participate in Regional and National Competitions, perform at the Mall of America, and dance in multiple recitals & community performances. Once a year, we offer an optional trip. Teams have performed at Disneyland, DisneyWorld, California Adventure, Branson, Pigeon Forge, Nashville's Grand Ole Opry Pavillion, and onboard a Royal Caribbean Cruise ship. They have taken class at Radio City Music Hall, Broadway Dance Center, and at NYC rehearsal halls with performers from Broadway Shows. They host workshops at RVDA with touring Broadway performers, and have attended dance conventions in the Dells, Minneapolis, and Chicago. **Anything our Teams do outside the Minneapolis area, is always optional.** However, if committing to team, we do consider class time, rehearsals, local performances and local competitions a priority. All dates are provided at the beginning of the season.
